Finally, I want to thank the many entrepreneurs and founders who have been a part of the program—your energy, skill, devotion and creativity inspire us every day.

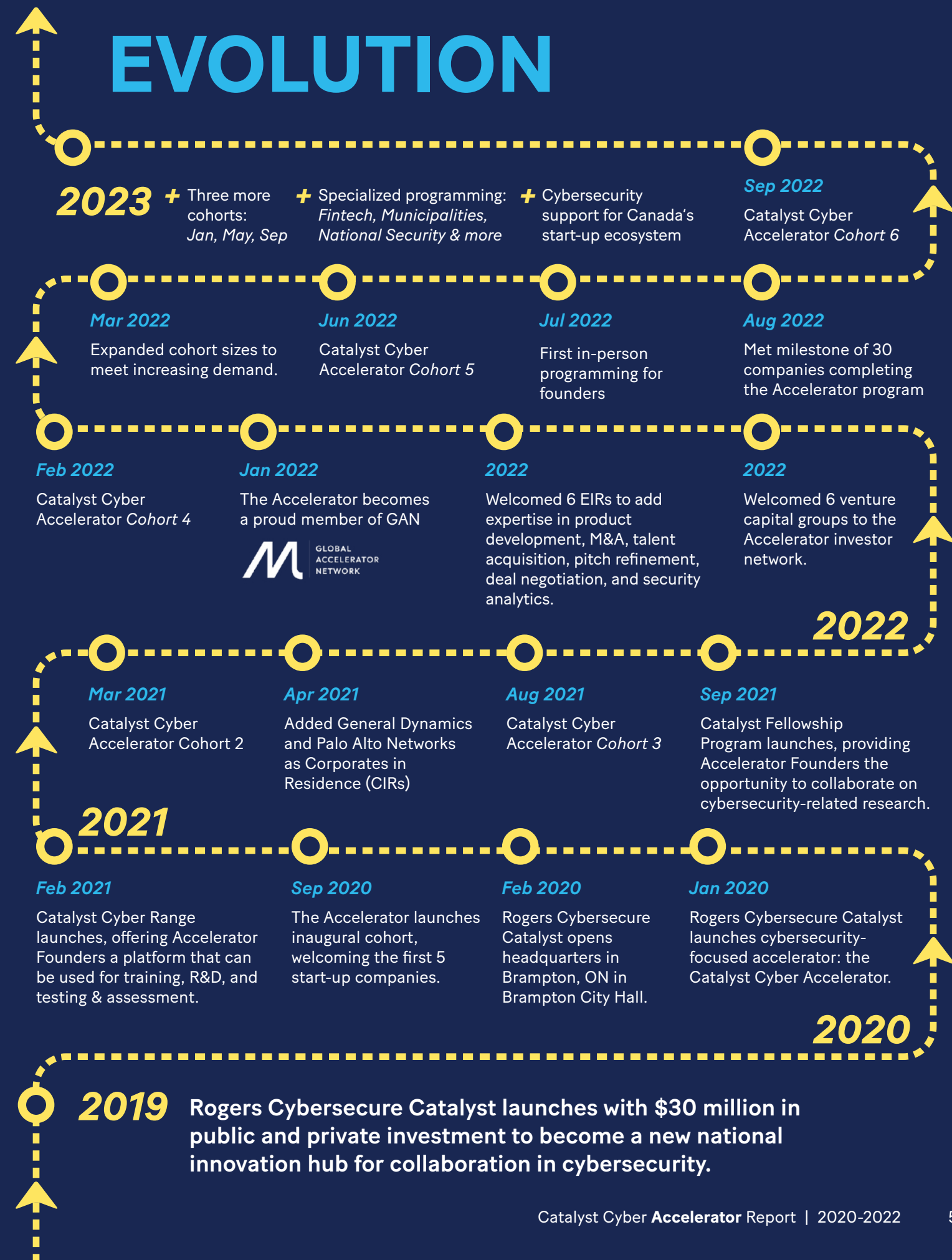

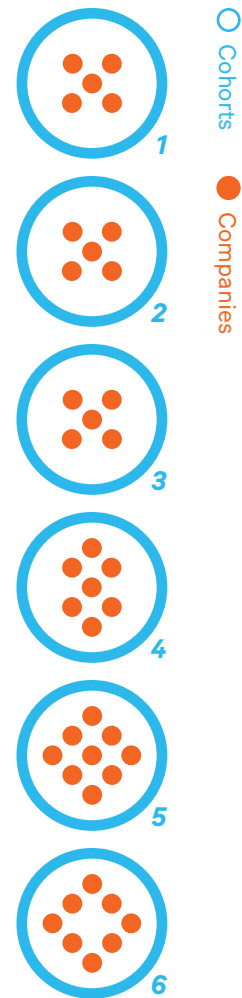

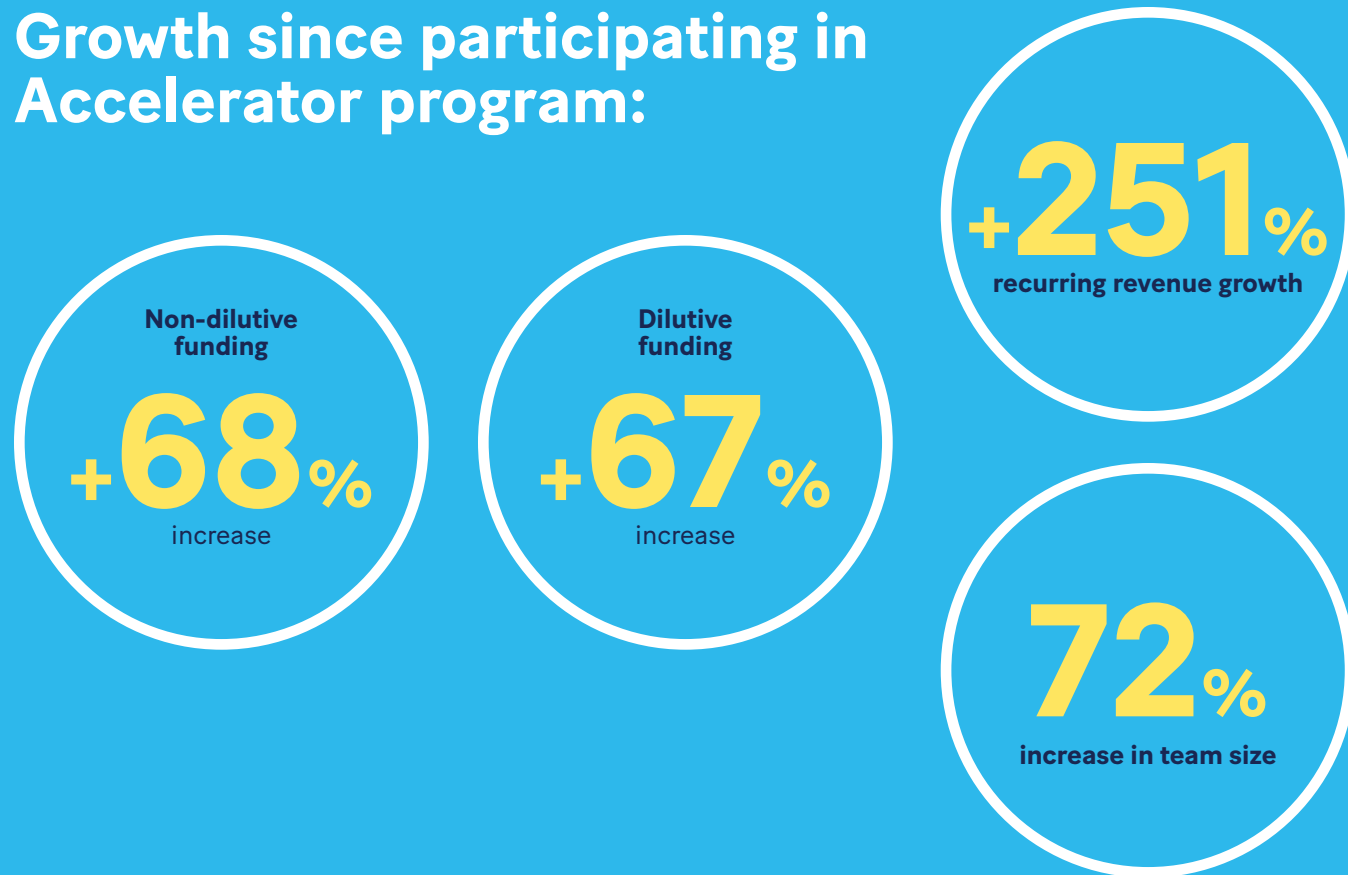
